



## SEM ESF – ‘In to Work’ delivered by Maximus

### Introducing ‘In to Work’

‘In to Work’ is a back to work programme funded by the European Social Fund and the DWP on behalf of the South East Midlands LEP, designed and delivered by Maximus UK and their delivery partners.

### How can we help people?

This programme is voluntary, part time and will support those who are furthest from the labour market, including those out of work for an extended period, to tackle barriers which prevent individuals from moving into sustainable employment.

It will provide a holistic approach to give personalised tailored support for individuals with multiple barriers to improve work readiness and employability skills.

### Where is it delivered?

In to work is delivered across the South East Midlands through a network of delivery partners and outreach sites in Milton Keynes, Luton, Cherwell, Bedford, Banbury and Aylesbury Vale. If the participant is unable to attend a delivery centre we can arrange to meet them at a location convenient to them such as a community centre.

MAXIMUS will be linking in with a variety of local specialist organisations in the South East Midlands to ensure people are given the right level of tailored support to help them overcome their personal barriers to work.

### Who is eligible?

Individuals must be unemployed or economically inactive and fall into one or more of the following categories:

- Long term benefit claimants – such as JSA or ESA or any other unemployment benefit (26+ weeks)
- Individuals with a self-declared mental health condition
- Lone parents
- People with caring responsibilities including unpaid carers
- Ethnic minorities
- Migrant Workers
- Ex-service personnel
- Those with housing/homelessness issues
- Ex-offenders
- Unemployed older-workers aged over 50
- Care leavers
- Young unemployed/workless aged 18-24





- Those living and out of work within rural communities
